PACIFIC SYMPHONY'S 8TH ANNUAL LUNAR NEW YEAR SPECTACULAR WELCOMES THE YEAR OF THE SNAKE ON FEBRUARY 1

Pacific Symphony welcomes the Year of the Snake with its annually sold-out Lunar New Year concert, a grand celebration of the rich traditions of Asian cultures brought to life through dynamic dance performances, soulful vocals, and a blend of Eastern and Western instrumentation. One of the largest Lunar New Year events in the area, the concert brings together more than 200 community performers and highly acclaimed guest artists in performance with the orchestra, led by Music Director Carl St.Clair. The concert takes place on Saturday, February 1, at 8 p.m. in the Renée and Henry Segerstrom Concert Hall. "Our purpose at Pacific Symphony is to bring people together through the transformative power of music, presenting a diverse array of music that can be enjoyed by all," said Maestro St.Clair. "This Lunar New Year, we're honored to highlight the vibrant traditions of pan-Asian music and dance with a rich showcase of talented performers from both near and far—a vision made possible by the inspiration and dedication of our board member, Charlie Zhang."

Filled with awe-inspiring moments, concert highlights include Bei Bei Monter, one of the world's premier guzheng musicians performing the ancient 21-string instrument alongside children from the Lotus Bud Guzheng Academy. Plus, Grammy-nominated pianist and local virtuoso Joyce Yang (Irvine resident born in South Korea) shows off her dazzling talents in Rachmaninoff's popular Rhapsody on a Theme of Paganini. Other guest artists include erhu player Yang Liu, the Yaya Dance Academy, Violin Studio of Wendy Castille, long time artistic partner Pacific Chorale, the American Feel Young Chorus, led by Sam Wei-Chih Sun, and more.

A number of Eastern traditional and

classic folk songs are featured on the program, including Huanzhi Li's "Spring Festival Overture," "Yi Dance" and Yaxing Chen's "Galloping Horses." Western favorites include "The Swan" from Camille Sain-Saëns "Carnival of the Animals," and music from John Williams and Leonard Bernstein.

"My wife Ling and I are deeply honored to have helped bring Pacific Symphony's Lunar New Year concert to life each year for almost a decade," said Charlie Zhang. "This concert serves as a bridge using the universal language of music to connect the cultures of East and West and be united in celebration. Our commitment is to nurture this cross-cultural exchange and foster an inclusive society rooted in the spirit of community."

About Pacific Symphony Pacific Symphony, under the dynamic leadership of Music Director Carl St.Clair since 1990, has been the resident orchestra of Orange County's Renée and Henry Segerstrom Concert Hall for over 15 years. Founded in 1978, the Symphony is the largest orchestra formed in the U.S. in the last 50 years and is not only a fixture of musical life in Southern California but is also recognized as an outstanding ensemble making strides on both the national and international scenes. The orchestra presents more than 100 concerts and events each year and a rich array of education and community engagement programs, reaching more than 300,000 residents of all ages.

Pacific Symphony made its debut at Carnegie Hall in 2018, where it was invited to perform as part of a yearlong celebration of composer Philip Glass' 80th birthday. The Symphony made its first-ever tour to China the same year, with performances in five cities, including Shanghai and Beijing. The



Symphony has been recognized with multiple ASCAP Awards for Adventurous Programming and included among the country's five most innovative orchestras by the League of American Orchestras.

Pacific Symphony's discography comprises 15 recordings, mostly of 20th- and 21st-century music by such American composers as William Bolcom, John Corigliano and Richard Danielpour. In 2012 for Naxos, St.Clair and the orchestra recorded Philip Glass's "The Passion of Ramakrishna," a Pacific Symphony commission that appeared on the Carnegie Hall program. In 2023, it released "Fiat Lux" by Sir James MacMillan, a choral work performed with Pacific Chorale. The Symphony has also recorded for Harmonia Mundi,

Koch International Classics, Reference Recordings, and Sony Classical, among other labels. The Symphony has been recognized with multiple ASCAP Awards for Adventurous Programming and included among the country's five most innovative orchestras by the League of American Orchestras. The Symphony's education and community engagement activities have also been recognized by the League, as well as the National Endowment for the Arts.

LOOKING TO UP YOUR FITNESS IN THE NEW YEAR? THIS EXPERT SAYS TECH CAN HELP

From wearables to apps, New Year's fitness resolutions are getting a tech boost that's catching on, with T-Mobile customers spending 23% more time on average on fitness-related apps in the last year.

At midnight on New Year's Eve, many make a familiar pledge: to get fit.

For the nearly half of all U.S. adults who make fitness-related resolutions, technology such as wearable devices and apps can be key to keeping this pledge, said A'Naja Newsome, Ph.D., a Researcher and Assistant Professor at the University of Central Florida who has written about fitness technology. Newsome also hosts a podcast, Strength in the Details, on which she talks about the impact of mental health, nutrition and leadership on strength training.

"Technology has really been adapted and modified to be appealing to a wide genre of exercisers," Newsome said. "People just really have to prioritize what's going to be important to them right now and invest in that."

Your Goals, Your Way

There's no one-size-fits-all for fitness technology. Start with an assessment of what you value and what your fitness goals are, Newsome says. Whether you're planning to run an ultramarathon or signing up for your first gym membership, there's something for everyone to keep their resolutions.

"We have so many of these wearable devices that can track things like heart rate, calories, steps and more," Newsome said. "And then we have things like mobile apps where people can use paid or free services to track their daily physical activity behaviors."

Beginners can start with mobile apps that come with quick and simple workouts - and if they value aesthetics, they can invest in wearables that also serve as a fashion piece, she says.

Physical activity tracking devices have historically been geared to sport-specific

athletes, particularly in running and cycling. However, "we're also seeing it expand to outdoor sports like hiking, climbing and swimming, and we're even starting to see tech for things like flexibility and mobility training and special populations like pre- and postnatal individuals," Newsome said.

The expansion of these technologies is leading to a shift back to basic fitness practices, she says, with a focus on everyday activities and movements such as time spent standing, daily steps, breathing and meditation rather than specific, structured exercise routines.

"Wearable technology now is telling us what is happening with the rest of our day," Newsome said. "What is happening with our sleep? What is happening with our steps? What is happening with our sedentary behavior?"

The fitness technology market has grown as more people turn to apps to support their goals. Among T-Mobile customers, the average time spent per month using fitness-related apps - such as running, weight and fitness trackers - increased by 23% between 2023 and 2024.

And on America's largest, fastest and most awarded 5G network, customers can get uninterrupted streaming for their workout videos and real-time data feeds on their performance.

Newsome said she expects the mobile apps and wearable device markets to continue to grow in 2025. The next frontier is integrating these technologies into healthcare in the future, allowing for more holistic treatment plans and monitoring capabilities, she added.

Make It Personal

Choosing new fitness technology is a personal decision based on individual values and priorities. Now, artificial intelligence is taking personalization even further by creating workout plans tailored to an individual's unique data, Newsome said.




"AI is generating these customizable workouts for your home gym, for on-the-go, your travel, for those that are short on time," she said. "That's going to reach a demographic of people who maybe thought that they didn't have the time to exercise or for those that just didn't have the know-how to exercise."

Wearable tech, mobile apps and AI can be even more supercharged with human input, Newsome said. She advised people to consult with an exercise professional or their medical provider before embarking on a new fitness regimen or making significant changes based on their wearable technology data.

Social support is the key factor in helping people change their behavior, she said, so supplement the benefits from wearable devices and mobile apps by seeking out peers and professionals. She also advises to not rely on technology so much that it creates a barrier to reaching your goals, like skipping a workout because your smart watch ran out of battery.

With all the innovations that promise to up performance and get people moving, there's never been a better time to conquer your fitness goals. So as the clock strikes midnight on New Year's Eve, remember: Fitness technology can give you a push, but the most important piece of equipment is your willpower, and all it takes is the first step. You've got this! - (BPT)

2. Unplug

Make a resolution to take a break from technology every now and then. Constant screen time, with the overwhelming amount of information coming at us every day, can lead to stress and anxiety. Breaks from technology give your mind time to recharge.

Begin by setting boundaries, such as designated "no-phone" zones like the

dining table or bedroom, and experiment with "digital detox" days where you disconnect completely. Replace screen time with activities that nurture your well-being, like journaling, reading a book, or spending time with loved ones in person.

3. Connect with nature

While you're unplugged, find some time to get outside, whether it's a quiet moment in a park, walking the dog through your neighborhood or simply enjoying fresh air. Numerous studies show that people who spend even a small amount of time in green spaces have reduced anxiety, stress and depression.

4. Prioritize sleep

Ingredients:

- * 8 Eggland's Best eggs, large
- * 1/4 cup vegetable oil
- * 1 cup chopped white onion
- * 2 poblano chiles (about 11 ounces), charred, sweated, peeled, stemmed, seeded and cut into 1-x-1/2-inch strips
- * 3 tablespoons milk
- * 3/4 teaspoon kosher or coarse sea salt, or to taste
- * 1 pound red potatoes, peeled, diced, cooked in salted boiling water for 5 minutes, and drained
- * Pinch of freshly ground black pepper, or to taste
- * 1/2 teaspoon ground allspice
- * 3/4 cup diced queso fresco (about 4 ounces)



Method:

1. Preheat the broiler.
2. Heat the oil in a 10- to 12-inch broiler proof skillet over medium heat until hot but not smoking. Add the onion and cook, stirring occasionally, until soft and barely beginning to brown, six to eight minutes. Add the chiles and cook until they begin to brown lightly, about three minutes.
3. Meanwhile, in a medium bowl with a whisk or a fork, beat the eggs with the milk and 1/4 teaspoon of the salt until foamy.
4. Toss the potatoes into the onion mixture, stir in the remaining 1/2 teaspoon salt, the pepper and allspice, and cook, stirring occasionally, until the potatoes are completely softened, about 6 to 8 minutes.
5. Pour the egg mixture on top of the potato mixture and stir gently as the eggs begin to cook along the edges and bottom of the pan, 2 to 3 minutes. Sprinkle the cheese on top.
6. Place the skillet under the broiler and broil until the frittata is puffed and lightly browned on top, 3 to 4 minutes. Remove from the oven, cut into wedges and serve, or let cool and serve at room temperature. Happy New Year to all! - (BPT)

5 HEALTHY HABITS TO HELP REDUCE STRESS

Physical activity is linked to lower risk of diseases, stronger bones and muscles, improved mental health and cognitive function and lower risk of depression. It can also help increase energy and improve quality of sleep.

The American Heart Association recommends adults get at least 150 minutes per week of moderate-intensity activity, 75 minutes of vigorous activity or a combination.

Meditate

Incorporate meditation and mindfulness practices into your day to give yourself a few minutes to create some distance from daily stress. Some studies show meditation can reduce blood pressure, improve sleep, support the immune system and increase your ability to process information.

Practice Positivity

A positive mindset can improve overall health. Studies show a positive mindset can help you live longer, and happy individuals tend to sleep better, exercise more, eat better and not smoke. Practice positive self-talk to help you stay calm. Instead of saying, "everything is going wrong," re-frame the situation and remind yourself "I can handle this if I take it one step at a time."

Show Gratitude

Gratitude – or thankfulness – is a powerful tool that can reduce levels of depression and anxiety and improve sleep. Start by simply writing down three things you're grateful for each day.

Find a Furry Friend

Having a pet may help you get more fit; lower stress, blood pressure, cholesterol and blood sugar; and boost overall



happiness and well-being. When you see, touch, hear or talk to companion animals, you may feel a sense of goodwill, joy, nurturing and happiness. At the same time, stress hormones are suppressed. Dog ownership is also associated with a lower risk of depression, according to research published by the American Heart Association.

Understanding stress is an important step in managing and reducing it.

Consider these things to know about stress and how it could affect your life: Today, 1 in 3 adults in the U.S. report being worried or depressed.

Higher levels of the stress hormone cortisol are linked to increased risk of high blood pressure and cardiovascular events like heart disease and stroke.

The top sources of stress are money, work, family responsibilities and health concerns.

Work-related stress is associated with a 40% increased risk of cardiovascular disease like heart attack and stroke.

When creating our Top 10 list, we usually focus on great value wines under \$100. However, this year, with so many outstanding selections, I decided to create a premium list as a follow-up to our 2024 Top Ten. From wine festivals and elegant dinners to the premium "Beyond the Cellar" showcase at Torrey Pines and my Napa Valley trip, I'm sharing 8 exceptional wines, with Frank contributing two more. These are outstanding wines perfect for special occasions.

Antinori Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon Napa Valley 2021. \$300.

Profico pays homage to the Antinori family motto, "Te Duce Profico," meaning "Following your guide, I flourish," and serves as Piero Antinori's legacy wine. Crafted primarily from Cabernet Sauvignon with a touch of Cab Franc, the wine offers elevated aromatics, complexity, and fresh acidity. First produced in 2019, it embodies decades of innovation on Atlas Peak, yielding a structured yet elegant wine with concentrated flavors and a refined, mountain-grown character. Antinorinapavalley.com.

Chappellet Pritchard Hill Estate Cabernet Sauvignon Napa Valley 2021. \$300.

Founded by Molly and Donn Chappellet in 1967, Chappellet is now led by the second generation, continuing their father's vision on Pritchard Hill. The 2021 Pritchard Hill Cabernet Sauvignon, their flagship wine, is a Bordeaux-inspired blend (95% Cabernet Sauvignon, 5% Petit Verdot) aged 22 months in new French oak. This beauty had black currant, cassis, and blackberry notes with hints of cedar, tobacco, and dark chocolate, showcasing robust tannins and a

polished, elegant finish. Chappellet.com.

Chateau Montelena Estate Cabernet Sauvignon Napa Valley 2016. \$250.

The 2016 Estate Cabernet Sauvignon exemplifies the winery's unwavering dedication to its unique vision and terroir. The 2018 Staglin Cabernet is silky, detailed, and embodies a balance of old-world charm and modern precision. It's elegant delicate structure exudes pure class. StaglinFamily.com.

Antinori Tignanello Toscana Italy 2021. \$159.

The 2021 vintage Tignanello is considered to be the most acclaimed of the classic vintages since its inaugural year in 1970. The 2021 version is ruby red with intense purple hues and will be remembered for a vintage that promises power and finesse from the winemaker master himself, Piero Antinori. He was the first to coin the term "Super Tuscan" for wines that initiated the Tuscan blends of Sangiovese, Cabernet Sauvignon, and Cab Franc. Antinori.it/en.

ORANGE COUNTY CHEFS EXTEND A HAND TO LOS ANGELES AMID FIRES

The heartbreaking scenes of destruction caused by the wildfires in Los Angeles have left many of us feeling helpless, watching as homes, businesses, and lives were destroyed. The pain of witnessing such tragedy is overwhelming, especially knowing that some of us have close friends and family affected by the devastation.

But amidst this devastation, something beautiful has emerged - a sense of unity and solidarity. Communities across Southern California, and particularly in Orange County, have come together to support those impacted by the fires. Business owners, volunteers, and everyday citizens have stepped up to offer their help through donations, shelter, or simply lending a hand to those in need.

The response from Orange County has been nothing short of remarkable. Seeing the community come together with such urgency and compassion is uplifting in the face of such a devastating crisis. The financial contributions, volunteer hours, and critical supplies being donated are a testament to this community's heart and resilience.

One standout example of generosity is Kristin Martin, who is known for organizing fundraisers like Table for Ten, Festival of Chefs, and Chef Masters to support various charities. Martin has teamed up with several chefs to respond to the wildfire crisis. Days after the fires began, chefs like Robert Duval, Brandon Hall, and Rick Boxeth collaborated to cook meals for those impacted.

Duval, owner of Duval's Dishes and former executive chef of the Art House in Los Angeles, took the lead alongside Chef Hall of Time Well Spent Catering. Their initial goal was to cook 500 meals, but the support they received quickly expanded their effort to prepare 2,500 meals.

With help from Wing Lamb of Wahoo's Fish Taco, who facilitated connections with the Red Cross, and volunteers from the community, the chefs have continued to provide hot meals to first responders, seniors, and families. The operation has grown, with over 30 chefs volunteering each week and an extensive network of supporters coordinating food donations and transportation. These chefs will continue cooking at The Hood in Anaheim, where they've been using the commercial kitchen to prepare meals. The facility, generously offered free of charge, has become a central hub for this growing operation, allowing the chefs and volunteers to work efficiently. With the support of this space, the team can continue to cook and distribute meals to those in need, ensuring their efforts remain steady as fire relief continues.

Along with Duval, Hall, and Boxeth, Chefs Adam Navidi, Pascal Olhats, Alan Ramirez, Jason Yamaguchi, Keith Prante, and Michael Cample have joined the effort. The chefs are committed to continuing their work at The Hood in Anaheim for the next six weeks or as long as the need persists. They are working closely with the Red Cross to ensure that meals reach those who need them most. Donations are needed to purchase specific food items, including potatoes, carrots, pasta, ground beef, chicken, onions, marinara sauce, canned tomatoes, cookies, chips, pastries, water, drinks, gloves, dish rags, and cleaning supplies. Financial donations can be made through the California Love Drop and Table for Ten websites, where all proceeds support Chef Duval's efforts and the ongoing food distribution.

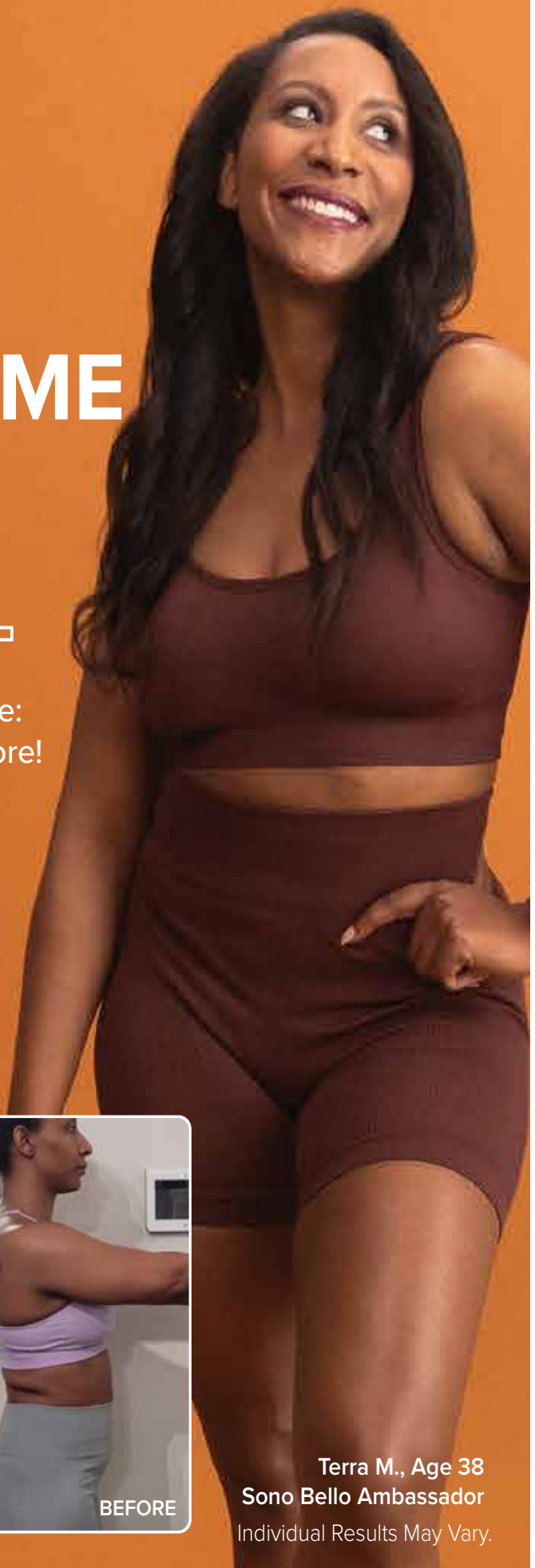
